The **Kailash Mansarovar Yatra** is a significant and spiritual pilgrimage to two sacred sites in Tibet: **Mount Kailash** and **Lake Mansarovar**. It holds immense religious importance for Hindus, Buddhists, Jains, and Bonpo followers. Located in the remote and high-altitude regions of the Tibetan Plateau, the yatra is considered one of the most challenging and revered pilgrimages in the world.

Spiritual Significance

Pilgrims believe that visiting Mount Kailash and Lake Mansarovar is a path to spiritual growth, self-purification, and achieving liberation from the cycle of birth and death (samsara).

The **Kailash Parikrama** around the mountain is particularly important, as it is believed that walking around the mountain helps the individual rid themselves of accumulated karmic debt and brings them closer to moksha (freedom from the cycle of life and death).

Itinerary

Day 01: Arrival in Kathmandu

Upon arrival in kathmandu, you will be greeted by our tour manager and transferred to your hotel for check-in. Our team will collect the passports of all nri pilgrims for processing.

Note: Pilgrims are advised to arrive at kathmandu airport before 9:00 am

Day 02: Kathmandu Sightseeing by bus

- Return to the hotel for lunch.
- Post-lunch, visit pashupatinath for the evening aarti, followed by the bagmati river aarti.
- Return to the hotel for dinner.

Day 05: Fly from Kathmandu to Lhasa

After breakfast, head to the international airport for your flight to Ihasa, a journey of approximately 1 hour and 10 minutes.

Upon arrival, our chinese guide will greet you and escort you to your hotel.

Gonggar airport to lhasa city: 65 km | 1 hr.

Altitude of Ihasa: 3,650 m | 11,972 ft.

Day 06: Lhasa sightseeing

Spend the day visiting the iconic potala palace, jokhang temple, barkhor square, and norbulingka palace. In the evening, you'll have free time to explore the city at your leisure.

Day 07: Drive from Lhasa to Shigatse (via Northern Highway)

In the morning, drive to shigatse along the yarlung tsangpo river, a 270 km journey that takes about 5 hours due to speed limits. In the evening, enjoy some free time to explore shigatse.

Lhasa to shigatse: 270 km | 5 hrs.

Altitude of shigatse: 3,900 m | 12,793 ft.

Overnight: Shigatse (Twin Sharing)

Day 08: Drive from Shigatse to Saga

Today's scenic drive takes you through picturesque villages and valleys, crossing at least four high passes before reaching saga, a small town near the brahmaputra river. The journey takes approximately 6 hours, with a picnic lunch along the way.

Shigatse to saga: 380 km | 08 hrs. Altitude of saga: 4,480 m | 14,695 ft.

Overnight: Saga (Twin sharing)

Hotel Guest House: Chunda New hotel Or Westin post

Day 09: Drive from Saga to Lake Manasarovar

Set off early for the long journey to lake manasarovar, a sacred site in hindu mythology. We expect to arrive by around 2 pm, allowing time for a holy dip and prayers. In the evening, we'll drive to chiugompa, performing a clockwise circumambulation of the lake.

Saga to lake manasarovar: 490 km | 7 hrsAltitude of lake manasarovar: 4,500 m | 15,250 ft.

Overnight: Chu Gompa (Four - Six - Eight Sharing)

Day 10: Manasarovar to Darchen

Overnight stay at darchen.

And enjoy darchen city and nearest darshan mt kailash

Overnight: Darchen (Twin - Triple Sharing)

Hotel Guest House: San sui New hotel

Day 11: Drive from lake manasarovar to yama dwar - start parikrama to dhirapuk

After breakfast, we'll drive to yama dwar (about 45 minutes), where the parikrama begins. The trek to dhirapuk, 10 km from yama dwar, takes about 5 to 6 hours along a gentle trail. Overnight stay in basic guest accommodations. Yama dwar to dhirapuk: 13 km | 7 h elevation of dhirapuk: 4,820 m | 15,810 ft.

Overnight: Dirapuk (Four-Six-Eight Sharing)

Hotel Guest House: New guest house

Day 12: Trek to shivastahl, gaurikunda (5,620 m), then zutulphuk

This challenging day involves a 22 km trek to zutulphuk, starting at 5 am. The trail initially ascends but becomes easier after two hours. We'll reach dolma la pass (5,800 m), the highest point of the trek, before descending to gaurikunda and continuing to zutulphuk. Overnight in basic accommodations.

Dhirapuk to zutulphuk: 22 km | 9 h

Overnight: Zuthulpuk (Four-Six-Eight Sharing)

Hotel Guest House: New guest house

Day 13: End trek in zuthulpuk, then drive to darchen to saga

After breakfast, trek to the endpoint near darchen (zhongdau), which takes about 3 hours.

Darchen to saga

Darchen to saga: 460 km | 7 hrs. **Zutulphuk to zhongdau:** 3 hrs.

Zhongdau to darchen: 4 km | 20 minsDhirapuk to zutulphuk: 22 km | 9 h

Overnight: Sage (Twin Sharing)

Day 14: Drive saga to shigatse

after breakfast, we'll retrace our route to shigatse via mayum la, paryang, and old dongba. Arrival

in the evening.

Saga to shigatse: 380 km | 08 hrs.

Overnight: Shigatse (Twin Sharing)

Day 15: Drive from shigatse to Lhasa

travel back to lhasa via the northern highway, a 5-hour journey due to speed limits. Enjoy some free time for shopping or exploring the city in the evening.

Shigatse to Ihasa: 270 km | 5 hrs.

Overnight: Lhasa (Twin Sharing)

Hotel Guest House: Brahmputra / shangrila

Day 16: Fly from Ihasa to kathmandu

In the early morning, you'll be escorted to gonggar airport for your flight back to kathmandu. Our staff will meet you upon arrival and transfer you to your hotel. You'll have free time for shopping or other activities

Day 17: Departure from kathmandu

transfer to tribhuvan international airport for your return flight. Please arrive at the check-in counter three hours before departure.

Tour ends.

- 7. Beverages (soft drinks, juices, etc.).
- 8. Additional expenses due to natural calamities or unforeseen events.
- 9. Any services not mentioned above.
- 10. Extra night in Kathmandu

To process your Tibet group visa,

we require,

A clear color scan of your passport and a 25% advance payment, to be submitted at least 60 days in advance.

To Payment Policy

- A booking fee of 500 usd per person is required to be paid in advance to the company.
- The remaining payment must be settled upon your arrival in kathmandu, nepal.

Booking Condition

In accordance with the regulations of the foreign exchange centre, a single permit will be issued for each group. To facilitate this process, we kindly request that you provide the company with a comprehensive list of group members along with clear passport copies a minimum of 8 weeks before your scheduled arrival in kathmandu, nepal. This will ensure the smooth issuance of permits.

This will ensure the smooth issuance of permit the original passport should be valid for minimum 6 months from the date of travel. v upon your arrival in kathmandu, nepal, it is essential to provide us with your original passport for the purpose of processing the group visa application.

To ensure a smooth process,

Please ensure the following: Travel is restricted to the individual for whom the permit has been issued. In the event of cancellation by that individual, the permit cannot be transferred for use by another person. For instance, if gunjan sharma chooses to cancel her yatra and intends for her son pratik sharma to take her place, such substitution is not feasible. Additionally, the cancellation charges will be applicable to the person initiating the cancellation.

Bring along 6 passport-size photographs measuring 33 mm in width and 48 mm in height. For your convenience, you can apply for a 30-day nepal visa in advance through the following link: https://nepaliport.immigration.gov.np/online alternatively, you also have the option to obtain an on-arrival visa at the airport.

Cancellation Policy

- 1. After the Group-Naming list has been submitted for the permit, any cancellations will incur a fee of USD 500 per person. (The permit application is made 60 days prior to the travel date).
- 2. If the Yatri cancels the tour 45 Days before the date of departure, 75% of total payment will be refunded.
- 3. If the Yatri cancels the tour 30 Days before the date of departure, 50% of total payment will be refunded.
- 4. If the Yatri cancels the tour 15 Days before the date of departure, NO payment will be refunded.

Emergency Departure & Associated Costs

In the event of an unforeseen emergency requiring a Yatri to depart the Yatra prematurely and seek to return, the Yatri will be fully responsible for any additional costs incurred due to this early departure. These expenses may include, but are not limited to:

- 1. Permit and visa cancellations
- 2. Transportation costs (e.g., return travel)
- 3. Meals and lodging
- 4. Medical care
- 5. Emergency rescue services
- 6. Any supplementary nights spent on the Nepal side of the journey
- 7. The Yatri will bear the full financial responsibility for these costs.
