




The **Kailash Mansarovar Yatra** is a significant and spiritual pilgrimage to two sacred sites in Tibet: **Mount Kailash** and **Lake Mansarovar**. It holds immense religious importance for Hindus, Buddhists, Jains, and Bonpo followers. Located in the remote and high-altitude regions of the Tibetan Plateau, the yatra is considered one of the most challenging and revered pilgrimages in the world.

Spiritual Significance

Pilgrims believe that visiting Mount Kailash and Lake Mansarovar is a path to spiritual growth, self-purification, and achieving liberation from the cycle of birth and death (samsara).

The **Kailash Parikrama** around the mountain is particularly important, as it is believed that walking around the mountain helps the individual rid themselves of accumulated karmic debt and brings them closer to moksha (freedom from the cycle of life and death).



Itinerary

Day 01: Arrival in Kathmandu (1300 Meters)

- Arrive at Tribhuvan International Airport, Kathmandu, Nepal.
- Nidhi Tours and Travels representative will meet you and transfer you to the hotel.
- Check-in at the hotel and have an evening briefing about the tour.
- Dinner at the hotel.
- Overnight stay at the hotel in Kathmandu.

Day 02: Kathmandu – Temples Tour

- After breakfast, embark on a sightseeing tour of Kathmandu.
- Visit key temples such as:
- Pashupatinath Temple(The largest Hindu temple),
- Guheshwori Devi,
- Sleeping Vishnu(Buddhanilkantha). Swyambhu Nath Temple
- Return to the hotel after the temple tour for lunch and leisure.
- Dinner at the hotel.
- Overnight stay at the hotel in Kathmandu.
- Small Brifing About Our Yatra

Day 03: Kathmandu to Syabrubesi (2900 Meters, 150 km, 08-09 hours drive)

- Early morning departure for the Nepal/China border (Timure/Syabrubesi) by reserved tourist bus.
- En route, pack breakfast and lunch.
- Arrive at the Nepal/China border (6-7 hours journey).
- Overnight stay at Syabrubesi guesthouse.

Day 04: Kerung Rest

- After immigration, enter Tibet.
- Meet your Tibetan guide, then drive to Kerung.
- Dinner at the guesthouse.
- Overnight stay at Kerung guesthouse.
- Rest for acclimatization and a brief exploration of the city.

Day 05: Kerung to Saga (4500 Meters) 220 KM (4 to 5 Hour)

- After breakfast, drive to Saga via Lalungla Pass (16,000 ft), Paigu-tso Lake, and the Brahmaputra River.
- Pack lunch on the way.
- Overnight stay at a Hotel in Saga

Day 06: Saga to Manasarovar (4558 Meters, 475 km, 07-09 hours drive)

- After breakfast, drive to Manasarovar Lake, with views of Mount Kailash.
- Have a parikrama (circumambulation) of Manasarovar by bus.
- Dinner and overnight stay at a guesthouse in Manasarovar.

Day 07: Manasarovar to Darchen (4575 Meters, 40 km, 01-hour drive)

- Morning puja and bath at Manasarovar.
- Drive to Darchen.
- Overnight stay at the Hotel

Day 08: Darchen to Yamadwar and Trek to Dirapuk (4900 Meters, 12 km, 06-07 hours trek)

- Drive to Yamadwar for Darshan.
- Start your trek to Derapuk (12 km, 5-6 hours).
- Pack lunch during the trek.
- Overnight stay at the guesthouse in Dirapuk

Day 09: Dirapuk to Zuthulpuk via Dolma La Pass (4760 Meters, 23 km, 8-9 hours trek)


- Early morning trek to cross the Dolma-La Pass (18,600 ft), the most challenging yet holiest part of the yatra.
- Descend to Lham-chu Khir River and continue to Zuthulpuk village.
- Pack lunch during the trek.
- Dinner and overnight stay at the guesthouse in Zuthulpuk.

Day 10: End Kailash Kora, Drive Back to Saga (475 KM 07 to 09 Hour)

- Early morning exploration of Milarepa Cave and complete the Kailash Parikrama.
- 3-hour walk to complete the parikrama, then drive back to Darchen.
- Lunch in Darchen and drive to Saga.
- Overnight stay at a Hotel in Saga.

Day 11: Drive Back to Kerung



- After breakfast, drive back to Kerung.
- Dinner at the guesthouse.
- Overnight stay at the guesthouse in Kerung.



Day 12: Drive Back to Kathmandu

- After breakfast, drive to the Nepal/China border.
- Complete immigration and cross the border.
- Drive back to Kathmandu and check into a hotel.
- Overnight stay at a hotel in Kathmandu.

Day 13: Final Departure

- After breakfast, check out from the hotel.
 - Transfer to Tribhuvan International Airport for your departure.

Service Includes

1. Accommodation in nepalgunj, simikot, taklakot, and tibet (tibetan guesthouses).
2. Vegetarian meals throughout the journey in tibet.
3. Transportation in tibet by luxury bus and vehicles around lake manasarovar.
4. Flights: Nepalgunj to simikot (fixed-wing aircraft), simikot to hilsa (helicopter), hilsa to simikot, simikot to nepalgunj (fixed-wing aircraft).
5. All domestic airport taxes, tibet group visa, and necessary travel permits.
6. English-speaking tibetan guide and tour manager.
7. Necessary supporting crew, including cook, assistant cook, and sherpas.
8. Emergency oxygen and medical kit.
9. Porter costs in hilsa for both directions.
10. Shoulder bag, duffel bag, down jacket, and raincoat provided by nidhi tours.

Service Excludes

1. Riding horses during the circumambulation.
2. Personal travel insurance.
3. Insurance for emergency rescue and evacuation.
4. Asthapad darshan (currently banned).
5. Personal expenses, soft drinks, and bottled beverages.
6. Tips for guides and drivers.
7. Extra accommodation charges due to flight cancellations.
8. International flight tickets.
9. 5% gst on additional services.

To process your Tibet group visa,

we require,

A clear color scan of your passport and a 25% advance payment, to be submitted at least 60 days in advance.

To Payment Policy



- A booking fee of 500 usd per person is required to be paid in advance to the company.
- The remaining payment must be settled upon your arrival in kathmandu, nepal.

Booking Condition

In accordance with the regulations of the foreign exchange centre, a single permit will be issued for each group. To facilitate this process, we kindly request that you provide the company with a comprehensive list of group members along with clear passport copies a minimum of 8 weeks before your scheduled arrival in kathmandu, nepal. This will ensure the smooth issuance of permits.

This will ensure the smooth issuance of permit the original passport should be valid for minimum 6 months from the date of travel. v upon your arrival in kathmandu, nepal, it is essential to provide us with your original passport for the purpose of processing the group visa application.



To ensure a smooth process,

Please ensure the following: Travel is restricted to the individual for whom the permit has been issued. In the event of cancellation by that individual, the permit cannot be transferred for use by another person. For instance, if gunjan sharma chooses to cancel her yatra and intends for her son pratik sharma to take her place, such substitution is not feasible. Additionally, the cancellation charges will be applicable to the person initiating the cancellation.

Bring along 6 passport-size photographs measuring 33 mm in width and 48 mm in height. For your convenience, you can apply for a 30-day nepal visa in advance through the following link: <https://nepaliport.immigration.gov.np/online> alternatively, you also have the option to obtain an on-arrival visa at the airport.



Cancellation Policy

1. Once the Group-Naming list has been submitted for the permit, any cancellations will incur a penalty for each individual. Please note that the permit application is processed 60 days prior to the scheduled travel date.
2. If the Yatri cancels the tour 45 Days before the date of departure, 75% of total payment will be refunded.
3. If the Yatri cancels the tour 30 Days before the date of departure, 50% of total payment will be refunded.
4. If the Yatri cancels the tour 15 Days before the date of departure, NO payment will be refunded.

Emergency Departure & Associated Costs

In the event of an unforeseen emergency requiring a Yatri to depart the Yatra prematurely and seek to return, the Yatri will be fully responsible for any additional costs incurred due to this early departure. These expenses may include, but are not limited to:

1. Permit and visa cancellations
2. Transportation costs (e.g., return travel)
3. Meals and lodging
4. Medical care
5. Emergency rescue services
6. Any supplementary nights spent on the Nepal side of the journey
7. The Yatri will bear the full financial responsibility for these costs.
