



The **Kailash Mansarovar Yatra** is a significant and spiritual pilgrimage to two sacred sites in Tibet: **Mount Kailash** and **Lake Mansarovar**. It holds immense religious importance for Hindus, Buddhists, Jains, and Bonpo followers. Located in the remote and high-altitude regions of the Tibetan Plateau, the yatra is considered one of the most challenging and revered pilgrimages in the world.

## Spiritual Significance

Pilgrims believe that visiting Mount Kailash and Lake Mansarovar is a path to spiritual growth, self-purification, and achieving liberation from the cycle of birth and death (samsara).

The **Kailash Parikrama** around the mountain is particularly important, as it is believed that walking around the mountain helps the individual rid themselves of accumulated karmic debt and brings them closer to moksha (freedom from the cycle of life and death).



## Itinerary

### **Day 01:** Kathmandu

Arrival in Kathmandu:

Upon arrival in Kathmandu, you will be greeted by our tour manager and transferred to your hotel for check-in. Our team will collect the passports of all nri pilgrims for processing.

Note: Pilgrims are advised to arrive at Kathmandu airport before 9:00 am

**Overnight:** Kathmandu (Twin Sharing)

**Hotel Guest House:** Hyatt Regency , Raddison , Souttee , Yak And Yati

### **Day 02:** Kathmandu sightseeing by bus

#### **Morning:**

- Visit Pashupatinath temple
- Gruheswari devi temple (shaktipith)
- Buddha Nilkanth temple

#### **Afternoon:**

- Return to the hotel for lunch.
- Post-lunch, visit Pashupatinath for the evening aarti, followed by the Bagmati river aarti.
- Return to the hotel for dinner.

**Overnight:** Kathmandu (Twin Sharing)

**Hotel Guest House:** Hyatt Regency , Raddison , Souttee , Yak And Yati

### **Day 03:** Bhaktapur & patan sightseeing

Morning:

- Doleswar mahadev darshan
- Chang narayan temple
- Bhaktapur durbar square
- Lunch: Own cost
- Enjoy lunch at an outside restaurant.

Afternoon:

- Visit patan: Krishna temple and patan durbar square and evening briefing

**Overnight:** Kathmandu (Twin Sharing)

**Hotel Guest House:** Hyatt Regency , Raddision , Soultree , Yak And Yati

### **Day 04:** Shopping & Tour briefing

- Free time for shopping in Kathmandu's local markets.
- In the evening, a briefing will be provided about the upcoming tour.

**Overnight:** Kathmandu (Twin Sharing)

**Hotel Guest House:** Hyatt Regency , Raddision , Soultree , Yak And Yati

**Day 05:** Kathmandu to Syabrubesi by Bus ( 150 KM 07 Hour )

Depart for Syabrubesi by bus, with a stop for lunch at a roadside restaurant over looking the Trishuli River.

- After lunch, continue the journey to Timure
- Overnight stay at a guest house (no lift facilities). Dinner included

**Overnight:** Syabrubesi / Timure (Twin – Triple Sharing)

**Hotel Guest House:** Guest House Without Lift (Twin – Triple Sharing)

**Day 06:** Nepal Side Immigration & Border Crossing 02 Hour Drive

- Complete immigration formalities on the Nepal side.
- Walk 1.5 km to the border and cross the Friendship Bridge to the Chinese side.
- Complete Chinese immigration formalities (passport and permit checks).
- After immigration, we will wait for the Tibetan guide and bus, then drive to Kerung.
- Lunch and overnight stay at an inner Kerung hotel.

**Overnight:** Kerung (Twin Sharing)

**Hotel Guest House:** 07 Premier / Ji Long

**Day 07:** Kerung to Saga (230 km, 5 hrs)

- After breakfast, visit a Buddhist temple in Kerung for darshan.
- Return to the hotel for lunch and then drive to Saga for overnight rest and acclimatization.
- Dinner at the hotel

**Overnight:** Sage (Twin – Triple Sharing)

**Hotel Guest House:** Wester Post/ New Hotel Chunda

**Day 08:** Saga to Mansarovar (456 km, 8 hrs)

- After breakfast, drive from Saga to Mansarovar.
- Stop for lunch at Mayum La Pass.
- Continue the drive to Mansarovar, where you will change buses and begin the 85 km Parikrama of Mansarovar Lake.
- Enjoy a cleansing dip in the lake, followed by puja.
- Drive to Chu Gompa for overnight stay.
- Morning puja and shower the next day.

**Overnight:** Saga (Four -Six Sharing )

**Hotel Guest House:** Parmarth Muni Ji Ashram

### **Day 09:** Manasarovar to Darchen

- After lunch, drive from Mansarovar to Darchen.
- Optionally, travel from Darchen to Asthapad by car (additional 500 Yuan, subject to Chinese government approval).
- Overnight stay in Darchen with dinner.

**Overnight:** Darchen (Twin – Triple Sharing)

**Hotel Guest House:** San sui New hotel

### **Day 10:** Darchen to Dirapuk

- Early morning breakfast and then drive to Yamdwar (30 km, 1 hour).
- From Yamdwar, horses and porters will assist you with the 13 km trek to Dirapuk.
- Packed lunch along the way.
- Overnight stay in Dirapuk with dinner.
- If permitted, perform Charansparsh (touching the holy feet of Mount Kailash).

**Overnight:** Dirapuk (Four-Six-Eight Sharing)

**Hotel Guest House:** New guest house

**Day 11:** Dirapuk to Zuthulpuk

- After breakfast, trek 12 km to Dolmala Pass for darshan.
- Continue for another 11 km to Zuthulpuk. Horse Ride Not permitted
- Overnight stay at Zuthulpuk.

**Overnight:** Zuthulpuk (Four-Six-Eight Sharing)

**Hotel Guest House:** New guest house

**Day 12:** Zuthulpuk to Darchen to Saga

- After breakfast, complete the remaining 5 km trek to finish the Parikrama (total 45 km).
- Meet the Sherpa and Tibetan guide, then drive back to Darchen.
- Enjoy lunch in Darchen.
- Drive back to Saga (456 km).
- Overnight stay at a hotel in Saga with dinner

**Overnight:** Sage (Twin – Triple Sharing)

**Hotel Guest House:** Wester post/ New hotel Chunda



**Day 13:** Saga to Kerung (230 km, 5 hrs)

- After breakfast, drive to Kerung.
- Lunch in Kerung and an evening at leisure.
- Dinner at the hotel.

**Overnight:** Kerung (Twin-Triple Sharing)

**Hotel Guest House:** 07 Premier /Ji Long

**Day 14:** Kerung to Kathmandu

- After breakfast, drive to the Kerung border.
- Complete immigration formalities on both the Chinese and Nepalese sides.
- After crossing the border, drive back to Kathmandu.
- Enjoy a farewell dinner in Kathmandu.

**Overnight:** Kathmandu (Twin Sharing)

**Hotel Guest House:** Hyatt Regency , Raddision , Soultree , Yak And Yati

**Day 15:** Departure from kathmandu

- After breakfast or Your Flight Timing , you will be dropped off at Kathmandu Airport for your onward journey.

**Overnight:** Kathmandu To Airport

**Hotel Guest House:** Check out 12 AM

## Accommodation

1. 05 Nights in Kathmandu,
2. 01 Night in Syabrubesi or Timure ,
3. 02 in Kerung,
4. 02 in Saga
5. 01 night each in Chu Gompa, Derapuk, and Zuthulpuk (dormitory style, maximum 10-15 pax).

## Service Includes

1. Vegetarian meals during the tour (twin sharing).
2. Airport transfers and transportation to Kerung border.
3. Tibet group visa and trekking permits.
4. Guesthouses in Tibet (except in Kerung, Saga, Mansarovar, Derapuk, and Zuthulpuk).
5. Transportation in Tibet via luxury bus and around Lake Mansarovar in a green vehicle.
6. English-speaking Tibetan guide and a tour manager from our company.
7. Supporting crew (cooks, Sherpas) and necessary kitchen and camping equipment.
8. Yaks and yak men for the parikrama to carry food and baggage.
9. Oxygen for emergencies and a first aid kit.
10. Mansarovar entry fee and applicable taxes.
11. Shoulder bag, duffel bag, and down jacket trekking Stick and Rain Pouchu provided by Nidhi Tours and Travels.

## Service Excludes

1. Horse riding during the parikrama. ( horse and porter price parikrama route approximate 4000 yuan )
2. Travel insurance.
3. Emergency rescue and evacuation insurance (including helicopter costs).
4. Asthapad darshan (currently banned).
5. Personal expenses and soft drinks.
6. Tips for guides and drivers.
7. International airfare.

## To process your Tibet group visa,

### **we require,**

A clear color scan of your passport and a 25% advance payment, to be submitted at least 60 days in advance.

## To Payment Policy



- A booking fee of 500 usd per person is required to be paid in advance to the company.
- The remaining payment must be settled upon your arrival in kathmandu, nepal.

## Booking Condition

In accordance with the regulations of the foreign exchange centre, a single permit will be issued for each group. To facilitate this process, we kindly request that you provide the company with a comprehensive list of group members along with clear passport copies a minimum of 8 weeks before your scheduled arrival in kathmandu, nepal. This will ensure the smooth issuance of permits.



This will ensure the smooth issuance of permit the original passport should be valid for minimum 6 months from the date of travel. v upon your arrival in kathmandu, nepal, it is essential to provide us with your original passport for the purpose of processing the group visa application.



To ensure a smooth process,

Please ensure the following: Travel is restricted to the individual for whom the permit has been issued. In the event of cancellation by that individual, the permit cannot be transferred for use by another person. For instance, if gunjan sharma chooses to cancel her yatra and intends for her son pratik sharma to take her place, such substitution is not feasible. Additionally, the cancellation charges will be applicable to the person initiating the cancellation.

Bring along 6 passport-size photographs measuring 33 mm in width and 48 mm in height. For your convenience, you can apply for a 30-day nepal visa in advance through the following link: <https://nepaliport.immigration.gov.np/online> alternatively, you also have the option to obtain an on-arrival visa at the airport.





## Cancellation Policy

1. Once the Group-Naming list has been submitted for the permit, any cancellations will incur a penalty for each individual. Please note that the permit application is processed 60 days prior to the scheduled travel date.
2. If the Yatri cancels the tour 45 Days before the date of departure, 75% of total payment will be refunded.
3. If the Yatri cancels the tour 30 Days before the date of departure, 50% of total payment will be refunded.
4. If the Yatri cancels the tour 15 Days before the date of departure, NO payment will be refunded.

## Emergency Departure & Associated Costs

In the event of an unforeseen emergency requiring a Yatri to depart the Yatra prematurely and seek to return, the Yatri will be fully responsible for any additional costs incurred due to this early departure. These expenses may include, but are not limited to:

1. Permit and visa cancellations
2. Transportation costs (e.g., return travel)
3. Meals and lodging
4. Medical care
5. Emergency rescue services
6. Any supplementary nights spent on the Nepal side of the journey
7. The Yatri will bear the full financial responsibility for these costs.
